**The House Calls Program** provides coordinated primary care services for seniors who have trouble getting to the doctor's office. Our goal is to give seniors the care they need in homes, apartments, and assisted living facilities. And, with a skilled team of doctors and nurse practitioners, we provide every patient with the expert care they expect and deserve.

Because our providers are part of Cambridge Health Alliance, a regional healthcare system, we are able to provide care at home and, when necessary, at the hospital.

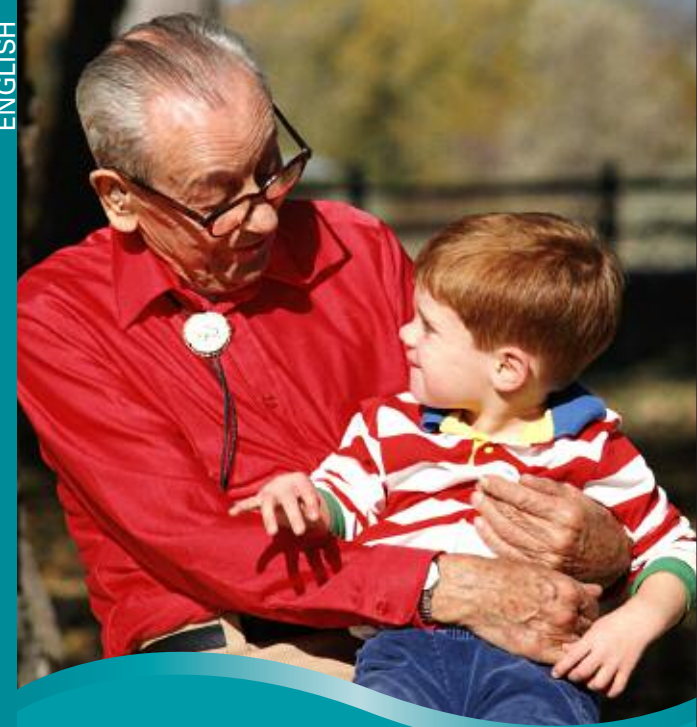


Our program lets us build strong relationships with our patients and to care for them in the most appropriate and convenient settings. We also work closely with community agencies and local Visiting Nurse Associations to bring services such as homemakers, health aides, physical therapists, and nurses to your home when needed.

Patients who need specialty care are often seen at one of our three hospital campuses – The Cambridge Hospital, Somerville Hospital and Whidden Memorial Hospital. Each location has top medical and surgical specialists, as well as mental health services. Our primary care physicians and many of our specialists are members of Harvard Medical School faculty.

## Program Benefits:

- There is no need to coordinate transportation. We come to our patients.
- We work with podiatrists and mental health providers who also make house calls.
- Patients have direct access to top medical specialists from Cambridge Health Alliance.
- We work within existing health coverage, so there is no additional cost to the patient.
- Our care is seamless – we follow patients from their home to the hospital and work closely with the current caregiver.
- We coordinate care with Somerville-Cambridge Elder Services and other local agencies.
- Interpreters are available at no additional charge for doctor/nurse practitioner visits.
